Recommendation for Design-Build Services Selection

The Selection Committee (Committee) has selected a Design-Builder to provide services for the above referenced project. Attached is the ranking summary of the Proposers for the project. The selection procedures were conducted in accordance with the HRSD Procurement Policy as follows:

- The Committee issued a Public Notice and Request For Qualifications on February 9, 2020.
- Four (4) firms submitted Statement of Qualifications on March 10, 2020, and all four (4) Proposers were preliminarily determined to be responsive and deemed fully qualified, responsible, and suitable.
- The Committee developed preliminary rankings and short listed two (2) Proposers based on evaluations using the Statement of Qualifications, the experience of the Committee members, and the Evaluation Criteria for Short-List Step specified in the Requests For Qualifications.
- The Committee issued a Request for Proposals to the two (2) short listed Proposers on April 24, 2020. The Proposal Documents included the Request for Proposals, Price Proposal Form, Contract Forms, Conditions of the Contract, and General Requirements.
- The Committee held Proprietary Meetings with the two (2) short listed Proposers on May 20, 2020.
- The two (2) short listed Proposers submitted Technical Proposals on August 6, 2020, and both Proposers were determined to be responsive and deemed fully qualified, responsible, and suitable.
- The Committee conducted interviews with the two (2) short listed Proposers on May 20, 2020 and conducted extended interviews with both Proposers on September 23, 2020; and developed technical rankings based on a technical evaluation using the Technical Proposals, the subsequent discussions during interviews, and the Evaluation Criteria for Technical Proposals specified in the Request for Proposals.
- The Committee discussed in detail the technical rankings. There was a spread in the technical points.
- The Committee issued a Request for Price Proposals to the two (2) short listed Proposers on September 29, 2020 and included Price Proposal Alternates Form.

- The two (2) short listed Proposers submitted Price Proposals on October 2, 2020, and both Proposers were determined to be responsive and deemed fully qualified, responsible, and suitable by the Committee on that basis.
- The final ranking of the two (2) short listed Proposers is based on the evaluation by individual Committee members using the Statement of Qualifications submitted under the Requests For Qualifications, the Technical Proposals submitted under the Request for Proposals, and discussions with short-listed Proposers; evaluation of the Price Proposals submitted under the Request for Proposals; and the Evaluation Criteria for Ranking Step specified in the Request for Proposals.

The Committee recommends award to the top ranked Design-Builder, Ulliman Schutte – Alberici JV, and that the Selection Committee be authorized to negotiate a Comprehensive Agreement with the Design-Builder. The Committee acknowledges that the Price Proposal submitted by the Design-Builder exceeds HRSD’s approved capital budget for these projects and negotiation with the Design-Builder will address this concern.
