

## Wastewater Discharge Authorization Criteria for a Calculated COD:BOD Ratio

Under certain conditions, wastewaters characterized by a calculated COD:BOD ratio greater than 6:1 will be authorized to discharge into the sanitary sewer system. COD concentrations above which HRSD will apply the COD:BOD ratio restriction of 6:1 are indicated in the table below.

## <u>Discharge Volume (gals)</u> <u>COD Criteria Concentration (mg/L)</u>

<1, 000	case by case basis
≥1, 000 <b>-</b> <5, 000	25, 000
≥5, 000 - <10, 000	10, 000
≥10, 000 <b>- &lt;25</b> , 000	5, 000
≥25, 000 <b>-</b> <50, 000	3, 000
≥50, 000 <b>- &lt;</b> 100, 000	1, 000
≥ 100, 000	750

If actual discharge volume data is not available, the permitted calendar month average discharge flow will be used.

All trailing zeroes are to be considered significant digits.
