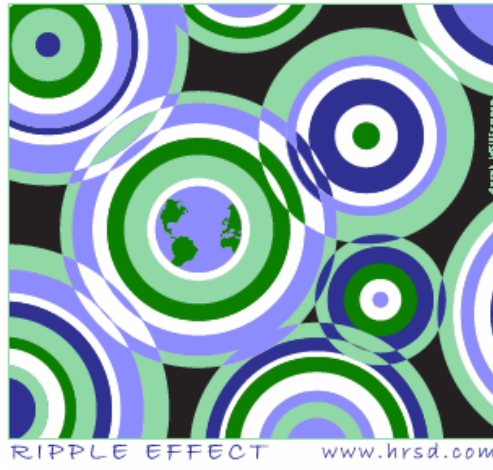


Environmental Art Contest for Virginia Beach High School Students

- Water Reuse is Water Wise and www.hrsd.com may be added when the design is reproduced.
- The winning design may appear on t-shirts, mugs or other give-away items produced by HRSD.
