



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE UPDATE for HAMPTON September 2017

Kecoughtan Road Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement Construction

--KECOUGHTAN AND IVY HOME ROAD INTERSECTION WORK--

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, continues working on a project to replace approximately 1,000 linear feet section of sanitary sewer pipelines connecting to and located along Kecoughtan Road from Ivy Home Road to Clyde Street.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- The contractor will begin pipeline installation work crossing the intersection at Kecoughtan Road from one side of Ivy Home Road to the other.
- Kecoughtan Road will maintain open with one lane of traffic in each direction.
- No left-hand turns at the intersection will be available in any direction.
- A new detour will be in place to assist motorists navigating the construction.
- In an effort to complete this work as quickly as possible, work hours will be extended hours from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m., 7 days a week until completed.
- This work is estimated to take three to four weeks and is weather and situation dependent.

While our project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice increased noise, traffic and the crews and heavy equipment (with back-up safety alarms) associated with construction. Please take care when traveling around the construction area and for your safety, do not enter the site.
