

Kecoughtan Road Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement Construction

-- IVY HOME ROAD WORK --

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, continues working on a project to replace approximately 1,000 linear feet section of sanitary sewer pipelines connecting to and located along Kecoughtan Road from Ivy Home Road to Clyde Street.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

In the upcoming weeks, the contractor will begin the pipeline installation work along a portion (a few 100 feet) of Ivy Home Road moving west from the Kecoughtan Road intersection.

- **Ivy Home Road will be closed to thru traffic during this work.**
- **Access for residents will be available from Victoria Boulevard.**
- **No entry onto Kecoughtan Road will be available from Ivy Home Road.**
- **A new detour will assist motorists navigate the construction.**
- **This work is estimated to take one month and is weather and situation dependent.**

While our project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice increased noise, traffic and the crews and heavy equipment (with back-up safety alarms) associated with construction. Please take care when traveling around the construction area and for your safety, do not enter the site.
