Night construction to continue on Laskin Road

**— Temporary lane closure to be installed nightly
from 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. —**

VIRGINIA BEACH – Construction crews will continue night work on Laskin Road near Chapel Lakes Drive until mid-July. Temporary lane closures will be installed at 9:00 p.m. each evening and removed by 7:00 a.m. each morning to minimize the effect on area traffic.

In order to safely install a new pipeline, portions of the northern most westbound lane will be temporarily closed between Chapel Lakes Drive and Great Neck Road. The lane closure will advance as pipe construction progresses, and will be kept to the minimum required to facilitate construction. During this time, traffic traveling west will be reduced to one lane.
