Night construction to resume on Laskin Road August 17

- Temporary lane closures to be installed between Hilltop Road and Captain George's Restaurant at 9:00 p.m. and removed by 7:00 a.m. –

VIRGINIA BEACH - Construction crews will work on Laskin Road every night but Saturday until the end of August. Temporary lane closures will be installed between Hilltop Road and Captain George's restaurant at 9:00 p.m. and removed by 7:00 a.m. each morning to minimize the effect on area traffic. Access to Captain George's restaurant and other businesses along the service road will be maintained at all times.

These temporary closures are required to safely install a new sanitary sewer pipeline. At least one lane of the service road and one westbound lane of Laskin Road will be open during these hours. The lane closure will advance as pipe construction progresses, and will be kept to the minimum required to facilitate construction.
