HRSD Pipeline to be Replaced in Your Neighborhood

Contractors are expected to begin replacement of an HRSD sanitary sewer pipeline in your neighborhood beginning Monday, June 27. Recent tests have shown that a portion of this 24-inch ductile iron pipeline has reached the end of its useful life. A valve will be inserted to facilitate the installation of new 24-inch PVC pipe in the existing right-of-way from Winslow Avenue to HRSD Pump Station # 138, which is on Shell Road near Forest Cove Drive.

The contractor, T. A. Sheets, Inc., will do its best to minimize any inconvenience during construction, which is expected to take about a month. There will be no interruption of your sewer service, and access to all residences will be maintained throughout the project. Nighttime work is not anticipated.
