HRSD Commission Elects New Officers

- Former Chesapeake City Council Member Serves as Chair -

William H. (Bill) Pierce has been elected chair of the Hampton Roads Sanitation District commission. A Chesapeake resident who has served on the commission for more than a year, Pierce is a former Chesapeake city council member. R. Tyler Bland III, former mayor of West Point, was elected vice-chair.

The eight-member commission, which is appointed by the governor, sets policy for HRSD, the regional utility that provides wastewater treatment services for more than 1.5 million people in 17 cities and counties.

HRSD, a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, was created by public referendum in 1940. Our mission is to prevent pollution, protect public health and support community development by providing wastewater collection, treatment and related services.
