HRSD operates the Chesapeake-Elizabeth Treatment Plant at 5332 Shore Drive, which has a design capacity to treat 24 million gallons of wastewater daily. You are invited to attend a public meeting to learn about planned improvements to the treatment plant. Built in 1965, the Chesapeake-Elizabeth Treatment Plant needs major renovations, which will improve the treatment process, enhance safety, and further reduce odors. Construction is expected to begin in April 2003.

- Provide your input prior to the final design.
- Meet representatives from HRSD and the engineering consultant.
- Learn about a major project to improve the treatment plant and benefit the neighborhood and the environment.
