Notice is hereby given that the Hampton Roads Sanitation District (HRSD) requests sealed proposals from qualified consulting firms (FIRM) to provide professional services to develop a Biosolids Resource Recovery Master Plan (BRRMP) to serve as a long-term, sustainable biosolids strategy for the organization. The scope of the plan will include biosolids processing and beneficial reuse including, but not limited to, land application, bioenergy and biofuel production, drying to produce fertilizer, gasification, centrate treatment, composting, digestion, and incineration, as well as other emerging biosolids technologies.

All proposers shall have prior experience with developing biosolids management master plans for similar sized organizations, knowledge of existing and pending federal, state and local regulations affecting biosolids and incineration, and expertise in biosolids processing, beneficial reuse and emerging technologies.

The evaluation and selection of the FIRM shall be based on an evaluation plan specified in the Request for Proposals. Any firm desiring consideration may submit a sealed Proposal to Patricia L. Hartman, Engineering Department Contract Specialist at the Hampton Roads Sanitation District, 1436 Air Rail Avenue, Virginia Beach, Virginia 23455-3002 on August 10, 2010 no later than 11:00 a.m. local time. HRSD shall evaluate each Proposal and select two (2) or more proposers for further consideration. HRSD shall select a FIRM on the basis of all information developed during the selection process that best serves the interest of HRSD.
