The Hampton Roads Sanitation District ("HRSD" and/or "OWNER") will receive sealed Bids for the above described project at the office of HRSD, 1436 Air Rail Avenue, Virginia Beach, Virginia 23455 until 2:00 p.m., local time on November 1, 2011, and then publicly open and read. Any Bids received after the specified time and date will not be considered.

Procedures for submitting a Bid, claiming an error, withdrawing of Bids and other pertinent information are contained in the Instructions to Bidders. HRSD reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive any informalities, or negotiate with the low bidder as described in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bid Documents may be examined at ENGINEER's office and have been provided to the following plan room services: Norfolk Builders Exchange; iSqFt; and F. W. Dodge/McGraw-Hill.

Bid Documents may be obtained from the ENGINEER'S office during regular business hours upon payment of \$100 per set or requested in writing (Attention: Scott Funk) with payment of \$125, including handling and postage. Return of the documents is not required and the amount paid for the documents is not refundable. Questions should be directed to Scott Funk, P.E. at 757-499-4224.

CONTRACTOR registration in accordance with Title 2.2, Chapter 43 and Title 54.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia is required.

The Project or Work consists of the installation of a new sanitary sewer pump station; approximately 1,300 linear feet of 24-inch gravity sanitary sewer, 16-inch and 20-inch sewer force main piping; approximately 300 linear feet of 30-inch casing installed by trenchless methods; connections to existing 20-inch force main piping through the use of linestops and bypass piping; and associated pavement and site restoration.

A pre-bid conference will be held at the HRSD Boat Harbor Treatment Plant, 300 Terminal Avenue, Newport News, Virginia 23607 at 9:00 a.m. on October 5, 2011. Attending the conference shall not be mandatory for those submitting a Bid.

A Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.
