The Hampton Roads Sanitation District ("HRSD" and/or "OWNER") will receive sealed Bids for the above described project at the office of HRSD, 1436 Air Rail Avenue, Virginia Beach, Virginia 23455 until 2:30 p.m., local time on January 5, 2012, and then publicly open and read. Any Bids received after the specified time and date will not be considered.

Procedures for submitting a Bid, claiming an error, withdrawing of Bids and other pertinent information are contained in the Instructions to Bidders. HRSD reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive any informalities, or negotiate with the low bidder as described in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bid Documents may be examined at ENGINEER's office and have been provided to the following plan room services: Norfolk Builders Exchange; iSqFt; and F. W. Dodge/McGraw-Hill.

Bid Documents may be obtained from the ENGINEER'S office during regular business hours upon payment of \$50 per set or requested in writing (Attention: Scott Funk, P.E.) with payment of \$75, including handling and postage. Return of the documents is not required and the amount paid for the documents is not refundable. Questions should be directed to Scott Funk at 757-499-4224.

CONTRACTOR registration in accordance with Title 2.2, Chapter 43 and Title 54.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia is required.

The Project or Work consists of the rehabilitation of approximately 261 linear feet of 39-inch and 2,099 linear feet of 42-inch reinforced concrete gravity sanitary sewer pipe and 7 sanitary sewer manholes (approximately 110 vertical feet) in Newport News, Virginia. The sanitary sewer is located along Jefferson Avenue between 42nd and 33rd Street. Also included in the project is the installation of 100 linear feet of 42-inch steel casing by guided bore methods and maintenance of sewage flows by temporary bypass pumping. Copies of the CCTV inspection of the gravity sewer shall be made available to Contractors upon request.

A pre-bid conference will be held at HRSD's Boat Harbor Treatment Plant, 300 Terminal Avenue, Newport News, Virginia 23607 at 9:30 a.m. on December 20, 2011. Attending the conference shall not be mandatory for those submitting a Bid.

A Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.
