Any Bids received after the specified time and date will not be considered.

Procedures for submitting a Bid, claiming an error, withdrawing of Bids and other pertinent information are contained in the Instructions to Bidders. HRSD reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive any informalities, or negotiate with the low bidder as described in the Instructions to Bidders.

CONTRACTOR registration in accordance with Title 2.2, Chapter 43, Code of Virginia is required.

The Project or Work consists of installing approximately 6,950 linear feet of 24-inch ductile iron sanitary sewer force main including bonding all pipe, relocation of utilities, excavation, backfill, dewatering, test pits, valves, air valves, valve boxes, branch connections, jacked in place pipe, and abandoning 130 linear feet of 24-inch piping with flowable fill.

A pre-bid conference will be held at Malcolm Pirnie, 701 Town Center Drive, Suite 600, Newport News, Virginia 23606 at 10:00 a.m. on April 30, 2010. Attending the conference shall not be mandatory for those submitting a Bid.

A Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.
