Title: Regional Residual Facility Charges

Date of Adoption: January 26, 2010

Date of Revision:

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1.0 Purpose and Need

Proper disposal of sewer cleaning residuals is directly related to HRSD's mission of protecting the waters of Hampton Roads by treating wastewater effectively.

2.0 Definitions

"Residuals" means non-hazardous material captured during maintenance and cleaning operations of the sanitary sewer collection system.

3.0 Guiding Principles

HRSD works to provide the most cost effective solutions for wastewater treatment and related operations to the regional ratepayer. Economies of scale should be considered when planning and designing facilities that address issues common to public collection system operators within the HRSD service area. Administrative functions that do not add value should be avoided when practicable.


4.0 Procedures

Subject to fiscal capacity, land availability and local land use considerations, HRSD will work to make facilities for proper handling and disposal of residuals available at locations accessible to collection system operators in Hampton Roads. Residuals from public collection systems in HRSD's service area will be accepted at no charge. Residuals from private systems in the area will be accepted for a fee to be established based on annual operating and capital costs.

5.0 Responsibility and Authority

The Operations Department will be responsible for the operations and maintenance of all HRSD Residuals Facilities. The Engineering Department shall be responsible for the planning, design and construction of all HRSD Residual Facilities.
