Contractor registration in accordance with Title 2.2, Chapter 43 and Title 54.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia is required.

The Project or Work consists of construction of a replacement pump station, force main tie-in, appurtenances, and the demolition of the existing Park Avenue Pump Station.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 1338 Porter Street, Chesapeake, Virginia on March 23, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. local time. Attending the conference shall not be mandatory for those submitting a Bid.

A Bid Bond in the amount of 5 percent of the Bid shall be submitted electronically with each Bid.

This project is being funded in part under the Virginia Clean Water Revolving Loan Fund (VCWRLF). Bidders shall comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 (Prohibiting discrimination in employment regarding race, color, creed, sex or national origin), No. 12138 and No. 11625 (Regarding MBE/WBE utilization). Bidders shall also comply with the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
