The Work for the West Point Pump Station No. 4 (Thompson Avenue) Rehabilitation consists of submersible pumping equipment and piping replacement, construction of a new wet well, conversion of the existing wet and dry wells to valve and instrumentation vaults, installation of gravity sewer and manholes, site improvements, retrofit of the existing control building with new electrical, control and HVAC equipment and flood protection measures. The Work for the Small Communities Rehabilitation Phase IV includes 2,100 linear feet of gravity sewer replacement/rehabilitation, point repairs, lateral replacements/rehabilitation and pavement restoration.
