The Hampton Roads Sanitation District (HRSD) (Owner) will receive electronic Bids for the above referenced project online through Owner's Online Oracle Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system (<https://www.hrsd.com/engineering-task-submittals>) by ~~October 22, 2025~~, November 5, 2025, no later than 2:00 p.m. local time. Failure to submit a Bid through Owner's Online Oracle ERP system prior to the due date and time will be cause for rejection by Owner. Procedures for submitting a Bid, claiming an error, withdrawing of Bids and other pertinent information are contained in the Instructions to Bidders. Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive any informalities, or negotiate with the low Bidder as described in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bid Documents may be viewed by logging into Owner's Online Oracle ERP system. All Bidders must be registered in advance of submitting a Bid. Contractor registration in accordance with Title 2.2, Chapter 43 and Title 54.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia is required.

The Project or Work consists of furnishing all labor, material and equipment for the installation of two HRSD-supplied refurbished dewatering centrifuges at the James River Treatment Plant (J RTP), all ancillary equipment and components, and modifications to existing facilities. In addition, a new electrical room will be constructed within the existing Centrifuge Building to house electrical equipment and create a conditioned space. Modifications to existing facilities include, but are not limited to, removal of existing Centrifuge No. 2 to be salvaged by the Owner, removal and installation of existing Centrifuge No.1 which is to be refurbished by Owner, centrate conveyance modifications, plant drain system modifications, non-potable water system modifications, and related civil, structural, electrical and instrumentation work at J RTP. The work generally includes, but is not limited to installation of process piping, electrical systems, control systems and associated trade work.

A pre-bid conference will be held at the James River Treatment Plant Conference Room on September 24, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. local time. Attending the conference shall not be mandatory for those submitting a Bid. A site visit will be held immediately following the pre-bid conference. Bidder must supply the company name, phone number and all employee name(s) who will be attending. No exceptions will be made for

additional or substitutions of people on the day of the pre-bid conference. No other site visits will be provided.

A Bid Bond in the amount of 5 percent of the Bid shall be submitted electronically with each Bid.

This project is being funded in part under the Virginia Clean Water Revolving Loan Fund (VCWRLF). Bidders shall comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 (Prohibiting discrimination in employment regarding race, color, creed, sex or national origin), No. 12138 and No. 11625 (Regarding MBE/WBE utilization). Bidders shall also comply with the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Bidders must certify that they do not and will not maintain or provide for their employees any facilities that are segregated on basis of race, color, creed or national origin.
