Contractor registration in accordance with Title 2.2, Chapter 43 and Title 54.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia is required.

The Project or Work consists of the installation of two HRSD-supplied refurbished dewatering centrifuges, the installation of gravity belt thickeners and several pump systems and the repair of a concrete day tank, steel day tank and fiberglass-reinforced FRP day tank. In addition, new electrical rooms will be constructed within the existing structures to house electrical equipment and create conditioned spaces. The work generally includes, but is not limited to, installation of process piping, electrical systems, control systems, and associated trade work. Structural modifications, including the stiffening of existing monorail beams to increase their capacity rating and hoists will be provided as indicated. Thickening and dewatering polymer systems will be upgraded to support the new equipment.

A pre-bid conference will be held at VIP Conference Room, 4201 Powhatan Avenue, Norfolk, Virginia 23508 on May 22, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. local time. Attending the conference shall not be mandatory for those submitting a Bid. A site visit will be held immediately following the pre-bid conference. No other site visit will be held.
