Failure to submit a Bid through Owner's Online Oracle ERP system prior to the due date and time will be cause for rejection by Owner. Contractor registration in accordance with Title 2.2, Chapter 43 and Title 54.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia is required.

The Project or Work consists of the complete replacement of a final effluent pumping station, replacement of secondary clarifier mechanisms, piping improvements in an existing pumping station wet well, site grading and landscaping for improved access and drainage, and associated structural and electrical work. Also, complex construction sequencing and temporary power provisions are required to maintain continuous plant operation.

A pre-bid conference will be held at Small Communities Division Operation Center, 310 Industrial Parkway, West Point, Virginia 23181 on January 15, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. local time. Attending the conference shall not be mandatory for those submitting a Bid. A site visit will be held immediately following the pre-bid conference. **No other site visit will be provided.**
