Contractor registration in accordance with Title 2.2, Chapter 43 and Title 54.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia is required.

The Project or Work consists of replacing 30 - inch diameter and 48 - inch diameter Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) diffuser headers and associated timber trestle structures with High-Density Polyethylene (HDPE) pipe and concrete ballast blocks.

A pre-bid conference will be held at James River Treatment Plant, 101 City Farm Road, Newport News, Virginia, Large Conference Room on April 30, 2026, at 1:00 p.m. local time. Attending the conference shall not be mandatory for those submitting a Bid. A site visit will be held immediately following the pre-bid conference. No other site visit will be provided.
