TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE FOR THRU TRAFFIC ON BAINBRIDGE AVENUE BETWEEN W. COUNTY STREET AND CAMERON STREET FOR UTILITY WORK

HAMPTON – Motorists are advised that <u>HRSD</u> crews will be installing sewer pipelines on Bainbridge Avenue between West County Street and Cameron Street as part of the <u>Phoebus Area Sanitary Sewer Extension Project</u>. During this work, motorists can follow a signed detour using West County Street, Libby Street, and Cameron Street as indicated on the map below. The detour for thru traffic is scheduled to begin as early as November 2 and is expected to remain in place for approximately 6-8 weeks.
