Two southbound lanes of Independence Boulevard between Virginia Beach Boulevard and Columbus Street to be closed through Tuesday morning

–Motorists encouraged to use alternate routes during peak commute times to avoid delays–

VIRGINIA BEACH, Va. – Two southbound lanes of Independence Boulevard between Virginia Beach Boulevard and Columbus Street will be closed through Tuesday morning, October 18, to allow contractors to work on a sanitary sewer pipeline. While two lanes will remain open to through traffic, motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes during peak commute times to avoid delays.
