Closure of two southbound lanes of Independence Boulevard between Virginia Beach Boulevard and Columbus Street extended

–Motorists encouraged to use alternate routes during peak commute times to avoid delays–

VIRGINIA BEACH, Va. – Two southbound lanes of Independence Boulevard between Virginia Beach Boulevard and Columbus Street will remain closed until contractors finish repairing a sanitary sewer pipeline. The work could take up to two days if custom fabrication of parts is required. Two lanes will be open to through traffic while this emergency work continues. Message boards will be used to alert motorists, who are encouraged to use alternate routes during peak commute times to avoid delays.
