Repair of HRSD Pipeline Underway in Chesapeake —Work Nears Completion—

HRSD crews are working to complete a repair of a leaking sanitary sewer force main near the 800 block of South Battlefield Boulevard in Chesapeake. HRSD crews responded promptly when alerted at 11:00 p.m. last night of a leaking 16-inch asbestos cement pipeline. The cause of the leak is not yet known. No traffic impacts are expected and the work is expected to be completed by the end of this weekend. The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality has been notified.
