HRSD to Rehabilitate Sanitary Sewer Along a Portion of Beach Road

HRSD, your regional wastewater utility service, conducts periodic inspections of our underground pipelines and manholes as part of our routine infrastructure maintenance program and in efforts to proactively prevent sanitary sewer overflows. During a recent inspection of our infrastructure along Beach Road, we identified the need to repair or replace approximately 600 feet of sanitary sewer **between Catalina and Westlawn Drives**. This project, which is anticipated to begin May 2, should be completed in early July.

HRSD has contracted the firm T. A. Sheets, Inc., to perform this work, which is weather and situation dependent, **Monday - Friday during the hours of 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.** The crews will do their best to complete the project quickly and minimize inconveniences. To accomplish this work safely and to protect motorists, **a portion of Beach Road (between Catalina and Westlawn Drives) will be temporarily closed while this work is being performed.** The use of traffic flaggers and detour signs will be utilized to assist motorists navigating through the area. This work and detour plans have been coordinated with the City of Hampton.

HRSD asks for your understanding as we undertake this effort to improve our system. This project will provide updated infrastructure that will enhance HRSD's ability to ensure that future generations will inherit clean waterways and be able to keep them clean.
