Maurice P. Lynch reappointed to a third Commission term

VIRGINIA BEACH – Virginia Governor Terry McAuliffe has appointed Elizabeth Taraski, PhD, of Suffolk to serve on the [HRSD](#) Commission.

Taraski is President and CEO of the Nansemond River Preservation Alliance (NRPA) with nearly 30 years of combined experience in environmental stewardship, senior fundraising management and a variety of areas critical to effective utility management. She has earned several degrees including a Ph.D. in Higher Education Administration at Seton Hall University, a Master of Science from New York University and a Master of Education from Rutgers University.

Current Commission member Maurice P. Lynch, PhD, of Williamsburg was also reappointed to a third term on the eight-member [Commission](#).

The HRSD Commission sets policy, provides direction and approves the HRSD budget. Commission members reside in the localities comprising HRSD's service area and serve four-year terms.

About HRSD: HRSD is a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia created by public referendum in 1940 and currently serves 18 cities and counties in southeast Virginia, an area with a population of 1.7 million.
