UPDATE: SANITARY SEWER MAINTENANCE WORK ON INDEPENDENCE BOULEVARD TO BE RESCHEDULED

Work will be done during a weeknight lane closure

VIRGINIA BEACH – In order to minimize impacts to weekend traffic, [HRSD](#) has canceled scheduled maintenance this weekend within portions of its sanitary sewer force main along Independence Boulevard. The work will instead be rescheduled to take place within a weeknight lane closure at a later date. Due to the nature of construction, dates are subject to change and are weather dependent.

This work is required as part of the [Environmental Protection Agency \(EPA\) Wet Weather Consent Decree](#) for Sanitary Sewer Overflows.

HRSD's mission is to protect public health and the waters of Hampton Roads by treating wastewater effectively. A political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, HRSD was created by public referendum in 1940 and currently serves 18 cities and counties in southeast Virginia, an area with a population of 1.7 million.
