Templeman Named HRSD Commissioner

Gov. Terry McAuliffe has appointed Ann W. Templeman of Hampton as one of eight members of the Hampton Roads Sanitation District Commission. Templeman is a Senior Business Support Analyst for Virginia Natural Gas with 30 years of experience in a variety of areas critical to effective utility management. She earned a Masters of Business Administration from Old Dominion University and a Bachelor of Science in Business Management from Virginia Tech.

Commissioners set policy, provide direction and approve the budget for HRSD, the regional public utility that provides wastewater treatment services for 18 cities and counties in southeastern Virginia. Ms. Templeman will complete the unexpired four-year term of Susan M. Rotkis, who resigned.
