Detour at Intersection of Nimmo Parkway and General Booth Boulevard to Remain in Place through This Afternoon

VIRGINIA BEACH – Difficulties experienced this weekend with the connection of a new sanitary sewer pipeline have required continued closure of all existing Nimmo Parkway eastbound lanes between General Booth Boulevard and Wisteria Lane. Police officers will be present to direct motorists through the Nimmo Parkway and General Booth Boulevard intersection.

Until weather conditions allow completion of paving, one westbound lane of traffic along Nimmo Parkway will be converted to an eastbound lane, primarily to maintain local traffic access to Redmill Landing. Other motorists are strongly encouraged to follow the detour which will be in place. Detoured traffic will be routed around the work zone via Princess Anne Road, Elson Green Avenue and Upton Drive.

The work should be finished late this afternoon, Monday, April 7, 2014. We apologize for any inconvenience caused by this project, which is essential to ensure HRSD has the infrastructure required to protect public health and our region's waterways.
