



## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE UPDATE (#6) July 2017

### Bridge Street Pump Station --Newport News Waterline Work--

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, continues work to construct a new sanitary sewer pump station at 515 Bridge Street. The new structure, which was designed to blend into the neighborhood, will replace the facility built in 1945

*This HRSD project is unrelated to the City of Hampton managed Bridge Street bridge replacement project over Salters Creek.*

As part of this effort, **Newport News Waterworks** will need to relocate some previously un-marked water pipelines that conflict with the sewer pipeline's design path. While these relocations are underway, you may notice decreased pressure in your service and at times no service available. This work should not take more than a few hours to complete.

This work will take place in two locations along Bridge Street: one at Marrow Street and the second at the opposite end of Bridge Street near Victoria.

**This work is scheduled to occur on Tuesday, July 11** and is weather and situation dependent.

While our project team will work diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice increased noise, traffic, the crews, and heavy equipment associated with construction. Please take care when traveling around the construction area and for your safety, do not enter the construction sites.
