## Bridge Street Pump Station

-- Aboveground Construction Work Begins —

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, continues work to construct a new sanitary sewer pump station at 515 Bridge Street. The new structure, which was designed to blend into the neighborhood, will replace the facility built in 1945

*This HRSD project is unrelated to the City of Hampton managed Bridge Street bridge replacement project over Salters Creek.*

The contractor has completed the second of five phases of work. Phase 2 included the underground structural work to create the deep basement like structure to house the pumps.

During Phase 3, the contractor will begin to form the above ground structure that will house all of the pumps and controls for the new station. This work likely will look more familiar to residents as the aboveground structure begins to take shape. Additionally some installation of curb and gutter and pavement restoration on Bridge Street will occur.

This phase is expected to last until winter 2017.

While our project team will work diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice increased noise, traffic, the crews, and heavy equipment associated with construction. Please take care when traveling around the construction area and for your safety, do not enter the construction sites.
