



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE UPDATE for NEWPORT NEWS September 2017

Chesapeake Avenue Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement --Work to Begin--

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, is undertaking a project to replace a sanitary sewer pipeline located along a portion of **Chesapeake Avenue from the Monitor Merrimac Overlook Park to the HRSD Pumping Station near Claremont Avenue**. This work should take place primarily between the hours of **8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday**.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- In the upcoming weeks, the contractor will begin preparing the site for work and the installation of new pipe
- The contractor will use a rolling construction method meaning – you will see work begin at the Monitor Merrimac Overlook Park, moving towards your home or business, complete the work adjacent, and then continue working as they move on towards Claremont Avenue
- During the Newport News portion of this work two-way traffic will be maintained
- This work can be weather and situation dependent and should not affect your water or sewer services.

While our project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice increased noise and traffic, the crews and heavy equipment (with back-up safety alarms) associated with construction. Please take care when traveling around the construction area and for your safety, do not enter the site.
