### Elm Avenue Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement

--Exploratory Construction Work Begins--

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, is undertaking a project to replace a sanitary sewer pipeline previously installed in the 1940s. The new pipeline will be located along Elm Avenue from South Street to County Street allowing the older pipeline to be taken out of service. This work is to take place primarily between the hours of **8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.**

This work should not affect your water or sewer services.

**In the coming weeks, HRSD's contractor will perform an exploratory excavation at the intersection of County Street and Elm Avenue to locate existing utilities and a location for the new pipeline to connect into the existing line. This exploratory work should last about a week. The remaining construction work will then occur in this spring.**

**This work can be weather and situation dependent.**

While our contractor and project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may experience typical construction noises such as equipment engines and back-up alarms, the crews and heavy equipment, pumps and hoses, materials being delivered, diesel generators and air compressors, sawing and the like should be anticipated.
