Mercury Boulevard at Ferguson Park Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement

-- Work Begins --

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, is undertaking a project to replace a portion of sanitary sewer pipeline located along Mercury Boulevard, between Jefferson Avenue and Warwick Boulevard. This work should take place primarily between the hours of **8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.**

In the upcoming weeks, the contractor will begin work to replace and repair sections of pipe both in the right of way and suspended from the Mercury Bridge, above the CSX Railway lines. There are no planned detours but flaggers may be used, as necessary. Entrances to neighborhoods and at least one entrance to businesses will remain available. The project should be completed in the summer of 2018. This work can be weather and situation dependent and should not affect your water or sewer services.

While our project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice increased noise, traffic and the crews and heavy equipment (with back-up safety alarms) associated with construction. Please take care when traveling around the construction area and for your safety, do not enter the site.
