

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – NOVEMBER 2016



Holland Road Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement-Phase I -- Public Sewer Force Main Work Continues --

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, continues a project to construct a new sanitary sewer pipeline to replace the existing pipeline built in the 1970s. HRSD is also working with the City of Suffolk to replace approximately 3,300 linear feet of water main piping in the Oak Ridge Subdivision as a part of this project. This work is to primarily take place between the hours of 7 a.m. – 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

This work is weather and situation dependent.

In the coming weeks, the contractor will continue the installation of the new public sewer force main. This work will begin on Delaney Drive, working south down Grove Avenue, towards Holland Road. There will be no disruption to your water or sewer service. This work is expected to last through the winter. Temporary paving will be placed as this work progresses. Detours will be utilized to safely assist with traffic flow throughout the construction areas.

After the new public sewer force main pipe has been installed, the contractor will then complete the public water service installations and make the private water connections.

Final paving will take place after the entire project is completed and will restore the roadway from curb to curb.

While our contractor and project team work diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice some noise, dust and increased heavy equipment traffic associated with construction. Please take care when traveling around the construction area and for your safety, do not enter the site. Thank you for your support of this effort to help achieve HRSD's vision:
