



## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE UPDATE for HAMPTON July 2017

### **Kecoughtan Road Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement Construction**

--Work Continues--

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, continues working on a project to replace approximately 1,000 linear feet section of sanitary sewer pipeline located along Kecoughtan Road from Ivy Home Road heading south towards Clyde Street. This work is to take place primarily between the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday – **pipeline connections will take place in the evening and overnight hours while flows are at lower levels.**

**In the upcoming weeks, the contractor will begin the installation of the two manholes within the public right of way, adjacent to your business and public sidewalk. The contractor will ensure that access to one entrance will be maintained throughout construction however, a few parking spaces may not be useable during this work. This work is estimated to take two – three weeks to complete and is weather and situation dependent.**

**This work should not affect your water but you may have short disruptions while the contractor reconnects the sewer services.**

While our project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice increased noise, traffic and the crews and heavy equipment (with back-up safety alarms) associated with construction. Please take care when traveling around the construction area and for your safety, do not enter the site.
