Norchester Pump Station - Phase 5

--Project Nears Completion--

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, nears completion of a new facility to replace the old Norchester Pump Station. The fifth and final phase of work, restoration is now underway and includes installing items such as: fencing, various plants and vegetation, paver grass, an odor control system booster water line, shutters and lighting.

The site restoration work is estimated to continue through late October. Norchester Avenue will soon reopen, allowing traffic to resume the traffic patterns in place prior to construction.

We will continue to work as quickly as we can during this daytime work (7 a.m.-4 p.m.).

Additional work will be completed once the contractor has left the site such as painting the 'safety orange & yellow' pump and I-beam white.
