

CONSTRUCTION NOTIFICATION UPDATE



Norchester Pump Station - Phase 5 begins --Testing and Restoration--

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, is nearing completion of the new Norchester Pump Station that will replace the previous pump station facility. The contractor has completed the construction work and we are moving into the fifth and final phase of work.

As always, this work is weather and situation dependent.

The contractor has completed the above and below ground construction of the new pump station. The remaining site work will include: startup and testing of the equipment for the new pump station; connection of a new manhole along Norchester Avenue to the new station, which will allow the bypass system, currently in the street, to be removed; site restoration efforts; and paving of Norchester Avenue.

This final work should take approximately two months to complete.

We will continue to work as quickly as we can during this daytime work (7am-4pm).

The bypass pumps will remain on-site and operate as needed in response to sewage flows to maintain sewer service until the new Norchester Pump Station is tested and becomes fully operational. You should not have any interruption in sewer service.
