

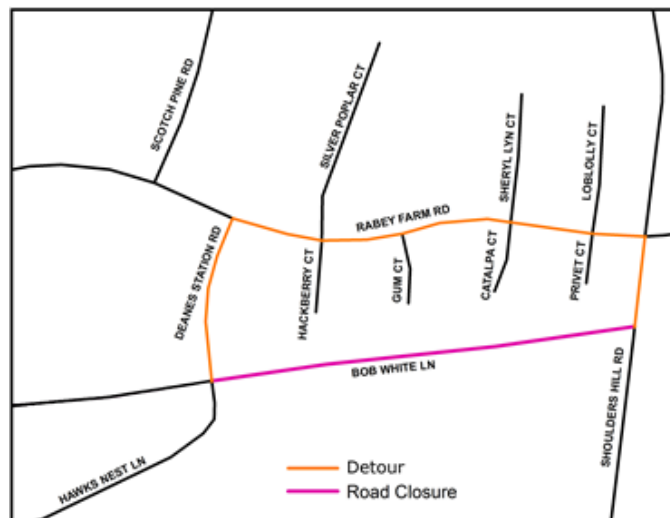
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## PORTION OF BOB WHITE LANE TO CLOSE TO TRAFFIC

**SUFFOLK** – For the safety of the motoring public, a portion of Bob White Lane from Shoulders Hill Road to Deanes Station Road will close beginning Tuesday, November 14 for continued [HRSD](http://www.hrsd.com) work related to the [Pughsville Station Upgrades](#). **Motorists entering and exiting Bob White Landing from Shoulder’s Hill Road will access Bob White Lane via Rabey Farm Road and Deanes Station Road.** This partial closure will remain in place through completion of this segment of work, estimated for late February 2018. The bike path will remain open to the public during this time.



This project is essential to ensure HRSD has the infrastructure required to protect public health and our region’s waterways.
