Riverview Parkway Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement

--Work to Begin--

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, is undertaking a project to replace the existing sanitary sewer pipeline located along Riverview Parkway and City Farm Roads. **This is the third and final section** of a phased project approach to replace the entire pipeline spanning Warwick and Boxley Boulevards, Menchville Road, and Riverview Parkway terminating within HRSD's James River Treatment Plant. This work is to take place primarily between the hours of **8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday**. This work is weather and situation dependent and should not affect your water or sewer services.

In the coming weeks, the contractor will begin the installation of the sanitary sewer pipeline. A majority of this work will occur in the public right of way along Riverview Parkway. There will be one residential intersection crossing at S. Menchville Road and Riverview Parkway and motorists will be assisted by the use of traffic flaggers.

Once the new pipeline is placed in service, the existing pipe will be filled with cementitious material and then left in place to minimize disruptions. This work is expected to last through the fall of 2017

While our contractor and project team works diligently to minimize impacts you may experience some odor, the construction crews and equipment noise (with back-up safety alarms) associated with construction.
