

Hilton Area Sewer Lining Project – Phase 1
CONSTRUCTION NOTIFICATION UPDATE #1
January 2017



Contractor to begin cleaning and inspecting sewer pipes in late January

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, is undertaking a project to rehabilitate approximately 8,200 linear feet of gravity sewer pipe, identified laterals, and manhole frames and covers originally installed in the greater Hilton area in the 1940s. This work, which is weather and situation dependent, is to take place primarily between the hours of **7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday.**

Prism Contractors & Engineers, Inc., which was awarded the contract for this project, plans to begin the first phase of this effort by cleaning and inspecting the sewers and several previously identified lateral pipes within the public right-of-way along the project path. Notices were previously sent to properties where lateral work is to occur, and the contractor will coordinate this effort with the residents. Phase 1 is likely to span several months.

While our contractor and project team work diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice some odor as the construction crews accomplish their work. You may also hear noise associated with construction and heavy equipment, including back-up safety alarms. For your safety and that of the workers, please take care when traveling around the construction areas and **be aware of children in the school zones and the neighborhood.**
