Downtown Norfolk Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement Construction

-- Intersection Work to Begin --

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, continues work on a major project to replace a sanitary sewer pipeline located along Atlantic Street and Main Street. This work is to take place primarily between the hours of **7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday**, although night hours may be required to minimize construction time as requested by the City of Norfolk.

During late September and October, pipe installation work is scheduled to take place in the intersection of Main and Atlantic Streets and subsequently along Main Street, between Atlantic Street and Martins Lane. At times, construction in this area will be suspended, and the work site cleaned, prior to and during any Downtown events. Once the pipe work has been completed, temporary pavement will be placed over the pipe trench to allow traffic to resume.

This work should not affect your water or sewer services and can be weather and situation dependent.

While our contractor and project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice the lights required for safety during night time construction, heavy equipment (with back-up safety alarms) and noise associated with construction.
