Downtown Norfolk Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement Construction

-- Construction work to begin --

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, is undertaking a major project to replace a sanitary sewer pipeline located along Saint Paul's Boulevard. This work is to take place primarily between the hours of **7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday**, although night hours and weekend work may be required, to minimize construction time as requested by the City of Norfolk.

In the upcoming weeks, pipe installation and tunneling work is scheduled to start. This work will begin at the Olney Road and St. Paul's Boulevard Intersection going south towards Brambleton Avenue. This work will mostly take place during daytime hours with some nighttime work. This work should not affect your water or sewer services. This work can be weather and situation dependent. Please see our website for up-to-date construction updates.

While our contractor and project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice the lights required for safety during night time construction, and heavy equipment (with back-up safety alarms) and noise associated with construction.
