Downtown Norfolk Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement Construction

-- Construction work continues --

HRSD, your regional wastewater treatment utility, continues work on a major project to replace a sanitary sewer pipeline located along Saint Paul's Boulevard. This work is to take place primarily between the hours of **7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday**, although night hours and weekend work may be required, to minimize construction time as requested by the City of Norfolk.

In the upcoming weeks, open-trench pipe installation work is scheduled to begin. Meaning, the contractor will dig a long trench in the pavement, place the new pipe in the new trench, cover the trench with soil and then cover it with temporary pavement-returning at a later date for the final paving work. This work will take place along the outer southbound lane of Saint Paul's Boulevard, from Market Street to Wood Street. This work will mostly take place during daytime hours with some nighttime work and should take one to two months to complete. This work should not affect your water or sewer services and can be weather and situation dependent.

While our contractor and project team works diligently to minimize impacts, you may notice the lights required for safety during night time construction, and heavy equipment (with back-up safety alarms) and noise associated with construction.
