MILLING AND PAVING WORK TO BEGIN ON BOXLEY BOULEVARD AND MENCHVILLE ROAD

NEWPORT NEWS – Residents and motorists are advised that [HRSD](#) will begin milling and paving operations on Boxley Boulevard this Monday, April 17, 2017. Work will begin westbound near Warwick Boulevard, moving toward Menchville Road. Hours of operation are 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday. Motorists will continue to have access to Boxley Boulevard in both directions at a reduced capacity for approximately 10 days until work is completed.

Milling and paving work is also scheduled for both sides of Menchville Road from the Menchville High school property line to Boxley Road, beginning, Monday, April 24, 2017. Hours of operation are scheduled for 7:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. Motorists will continue to have access to Menchville Road under a flagging operation for approximately 10 days until the work is completed.

Due to the nature of the work being performed, it is weather-dependent and may require additional time.

This work is part of the [Sanitary Sewer Pipeline Replacement Project: Warwick Boulevard to Boxley Boulevard Menchville Road](#), scheduled for completion by October 1, 2017.
