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TEMPORARY LANE SHIFT SCHEDULED ON WARWICK BOULEVARD FOR SANITARY SEWER PIPELINE INSTALLATION

NEWPORT NEWS – Residents and motorists are advised that [HRSD](#) is scheduled to install sanitary sewer pipelines across Warwick Boulevard between Abbitt Lane and the Peninsula Memorial Park entrance this Saturday May 6 and the following Saturday, May 13, from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Motorists should be prepared for reduced speeds and temporary lane shifts during this time.

A temporary lane shift will divert all southbound traffic to the median side of Warwick Boulevard's northbound lane, continuing down the median side of the northbound lane and merging back into the southbound lanes of Warwick Boulevard near the Peninsula Memorial Park entrance. The speed limit in this area will be reduced to 35 MPH during construction.

This work is part of the [Warwick Boulevard Force Main Replacement - Scufflefield Road to Peninsula Memorial Park](#) project.
