UPDATE: TIME CHANGE FOR SANITARY SEWER PIPELINE INSTALLATION ON WARWICK BOULEVARD THIS WEEKEND

NEWPORT NEWS – [HRSD](#) has adjusted the work hours for sanitary sewer pipeline installation work scheduled along Warwick Boulevard this weekend. This work, originally scheduled for Saturday, May 20 from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. will now begin at midnight on Friday, May 19 and continue until 6 p.m. Saturday, May 20.

A temporary lane shift will divert all southbound traffic between Abbitt Lane and the Peninsula Memorial Park entrance to the median side of Warwick Boulevard's northbound lane, continuing down the median side of the northbound lane. Traffic will merge back into the southbound lanes of Warwick Boulevard near the Peninsula Memorial Park entrance.

Motorists should be prepared for reduced speeds and temporary lane shifts during this time. The speed limit in this area will be reduced to 35 MPH during construction.

This work is part of the [Warwick Boulevard Force Main Replacement - Scufflefield Road to Peninsula Memorial Park](#) project. Work is weather-dependent and subject to change.
