

Wastewater Discharge Authorization Criteria for a Calculated COD:BOD Ratio

Under certain conditions, wastewater characterized by a calculated COD:BOD ratio greater than 6:1 will be authorized to discharge into the sanitary sewer system. COD concentrations above which HRSD will apply the COD:BOD ratio restriction of 6:1 are indicated in the table below.

Discharge Volume (gals)

<1,000
≥1, 000 - <5, 000
≥5, 000 - <10, 000
≥10, 000 - <25, 000
≥25, 000 - <50, 000
≥50, 000 - <100, 000
≥ 100, 000

COD Criteria Concentration (mg/L)

case by case basis 25, 000 10, 000 5, 000 3, 000 1, 000 750

If actual discharge volume data is not available, the permitted calendar month average discharge flow will be used.

All trailing zeroes are to be considered significant digits.
