Section III. Examples of Position Duties

- a. Maintains the requirements of a registered apprentice
- b. Attends class, completes coursework (usually at least two nights per week from September to April) and required on-the-job-training
- c. Performs maintenance and repair activities for treatment facility in a satisfactory manner
- d. Exhibits alertness and attentiveness to equipment requirements
- e. Prevents misuse and abuse of treatment plant property, equipment and resources
- f. Cooperates and works well with other treatment plant personnel
- g. Follows instructions and exhibits dependability

Section IV. Position Accountabilities and Expectations

- a. Adhere to the guidelines of HRSD's Apprenticeship Program Manual
- b. Ability to work effectively with a variety of personalities and to interact and communicate with individuals at all levels of the organization
- c. Ability to understand and carry out written and oral instructions
- d. Ability to recognize problems quickly and use good judgment in locating the most appropriate guideline or practice to follow with little or no supervision to solve problems
- e. Ability to follow technical instructions, procedures and schedules
- f. Ability to perform mathematical calculations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, percentages and ratios
- g. Must have working knowledge of standard office equipment to include a personal computer

Section V. Working Conditions

- a. Must be able to work in varying climatic conditions outdoors; indoor work environment may be routinely hot, cold, misty, and/or unventilated; work involves exposure to hazardous materials and handling of wastewater
- b. Must be available to work overtime and/or unusual hours as necessary
- c. Must be available to work shift operations as needed
- d. Must be immediately accessible by telephone in order to respond to emergencies according to a Standby schedule or as announced

Section VI. Physical Requirements

- a. Must have the physical dexterity to accomplish the duties defined herein
- b. Must be able to identify colors used in work
- c. Must have the ability to walk, climb, stand, or bend for over 50% of time
- d. Must have the ability to lift 50 pounds
- e. Must be medically certified to wear a respirator

Section VIII. Qualification Standards

- a. Education
 - Required

High school diploma or GED and Completion of HRSD's Maintenance Operator Apprenticeship Trade or equivalent as determined by HRSD's Apprenticeship Committee

- b. Experience
 - Required

Completion of the On-The-Job-Training skills portion of HRSD's Apprenticeship program for this trade, or approved equivalent as determined by HRSD's Apprenticeship Committee

c. Training Levels

This position is fully qualified at Grade 5, with experience and education as noted above. For those persons less qualified, the following training levels have been established:

- Grade 5a Successful completion of 22 academic course and 66% of on-the-job training skills
- Grade 5b Successful completion of 12 academic course and 33% of on-the-job training skills

Grade 5c - No experience

If assigned to a training level, fully qualified level must be consistently pursued, as a condition of appointment. Failure to do so will result in removal from the position and potentially employment with HRSD.
